The Port of Los Angeles strongly supports encouraging young men and women to enjoy the benefits of competitive sailing. Corinthian values that promote the highest level of sportsmanship, fairness, courtesy and grace in victory or defeat are valuable traits that all young men and women should aspire. Environmental awareness, stewardship and developing a love of the ocean are other important by-products of getting out on the water at an early age.

This trophy will be awarded to the winning team competing in the annual Port of Los Angeles Harbor Cup - Cal Maritime Invitational Intercollegiate Regatta. The Board of Directors of the Los Angeles Yacht Club shall have and retain full power and authority to determine all questions as to awarding the trophy.

The trophy shall be kept and displayed on the premises of the Los Angeles Yacht Club and maintained in good condition. The Los Angeles Yacht Club Board of Directors may authorize the trophy to be displayed at an alternative location at their sole discretion.


#### **Gary Jobson**

Gary was inducted into the National Sailing Hall of Fame (2011) and the America's Cup Hall of Fame (2003) by the Herreshoff Marine Museum. In 1999 Jobson won the Nathanael G. Herreshoff Trophy, US Sailing's most prestigious award.

As a broadcaster/producer (he is ESPN's Sailing Analyst), lecturer, and writer (he is Editor at Large for Sailing World and Cruising World magazines), Gary is the preemient ambassador for sailing in the U.S.






